




Introduction

The Global Food Security Index (GFSI) developed by Economist Impact and supported by Corteva Agriscience considers the issues of Affordability, Availability, Quality and Safety and Sustainability and Adaptation. The website presents the key findings from the 2022 report and allows users to explore how each country performed across each category. It also displays the country scores for each indicator that drives the index.

The website also allows users to download the GFSI 2022 report and the Excel model which contains the raw data.






